Responsive Reading *Caribbean Baptist Praise and Worship # 304*

Leader: Jesus said: I am telling you the truth: whoever believes in me will do what I do—yes, he will do even greater things because I am going to the Father.

People: I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, who will stay with you for ever.

Leader: The Helper, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and make you remember all that I have told you.

People: The Helper will come—the Spirit, who reveals the truth about God and who comes from the Father. I will send Him to you from the Father, and He will speak about me.
